

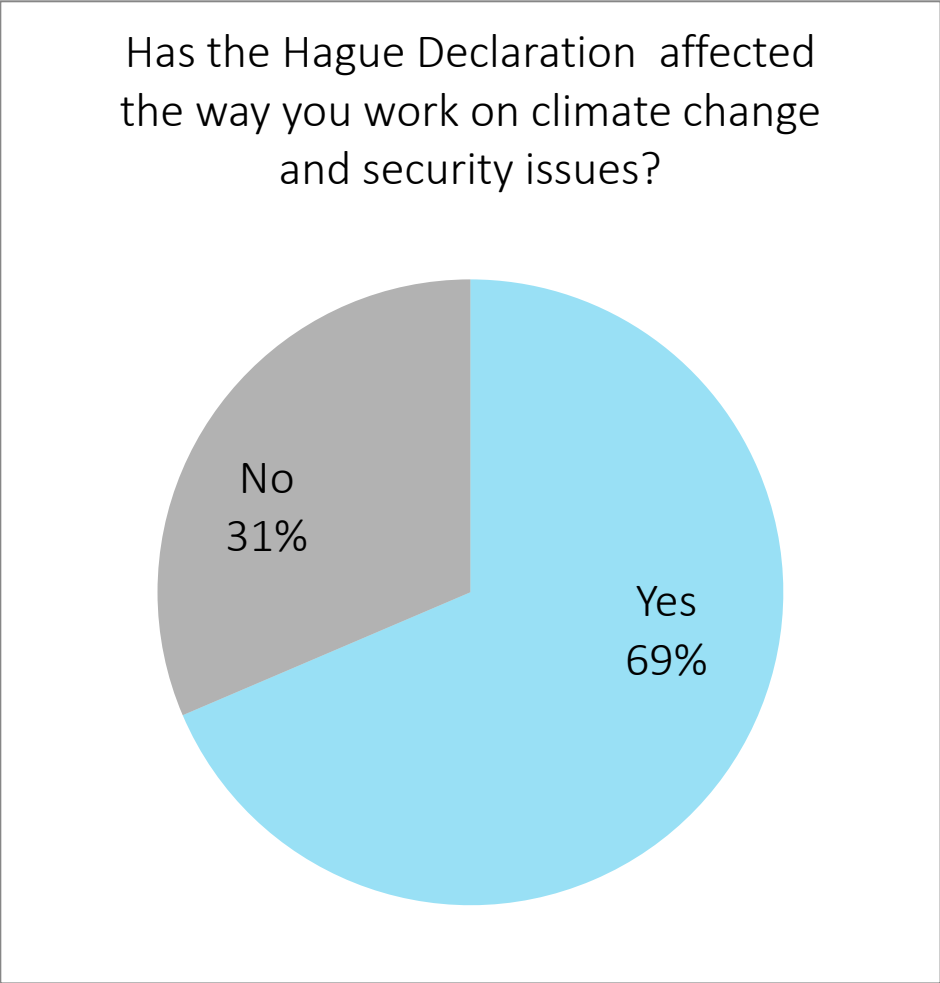
Hague Declaration Monitoring – Survey Results

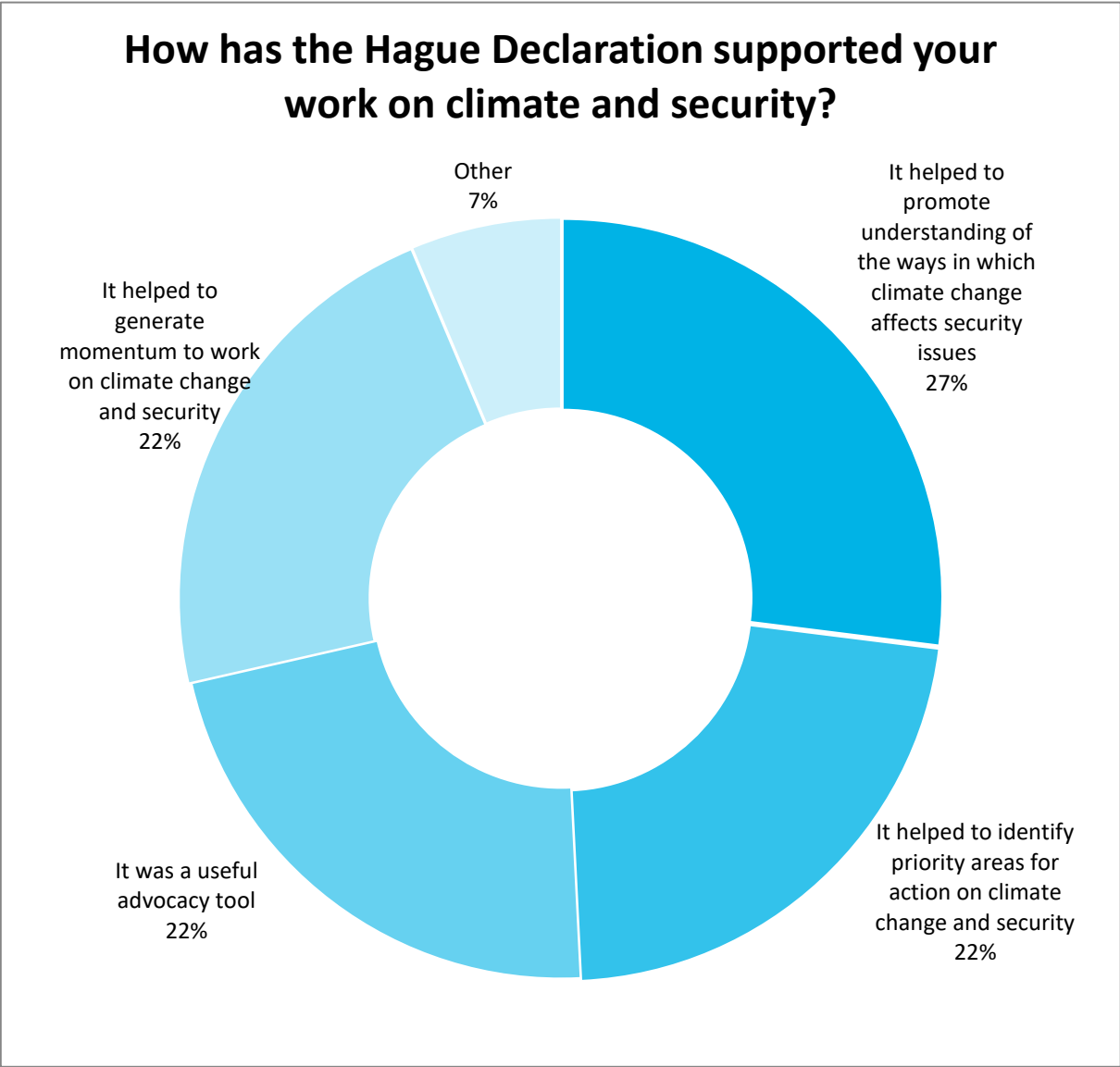
Information on the projects and activities presented on this website has been collected through an online survey among the signatories of the Hague Declaration and the wider climate and security community. The survey asked participants how their work relates to the Hague Declaration, what impact the Declaration has had on their work and which action areas they consider particularly relevant.

A majority of survey participants said that the Hague Declaration impacted on the way they address climate change and security in their work. For the majority the Declaration provided a tool to promote understanding of the interaction between climate and security. But also the impact of the Declaration to generate momentum, identify priority areas and its use as an advocacy tool is reflected in the survey results. Progress on the implementation of the Hague Declaration is shown in the answer of 86 per cent of participants who say that they have addressed at least one of the action areas in their work.

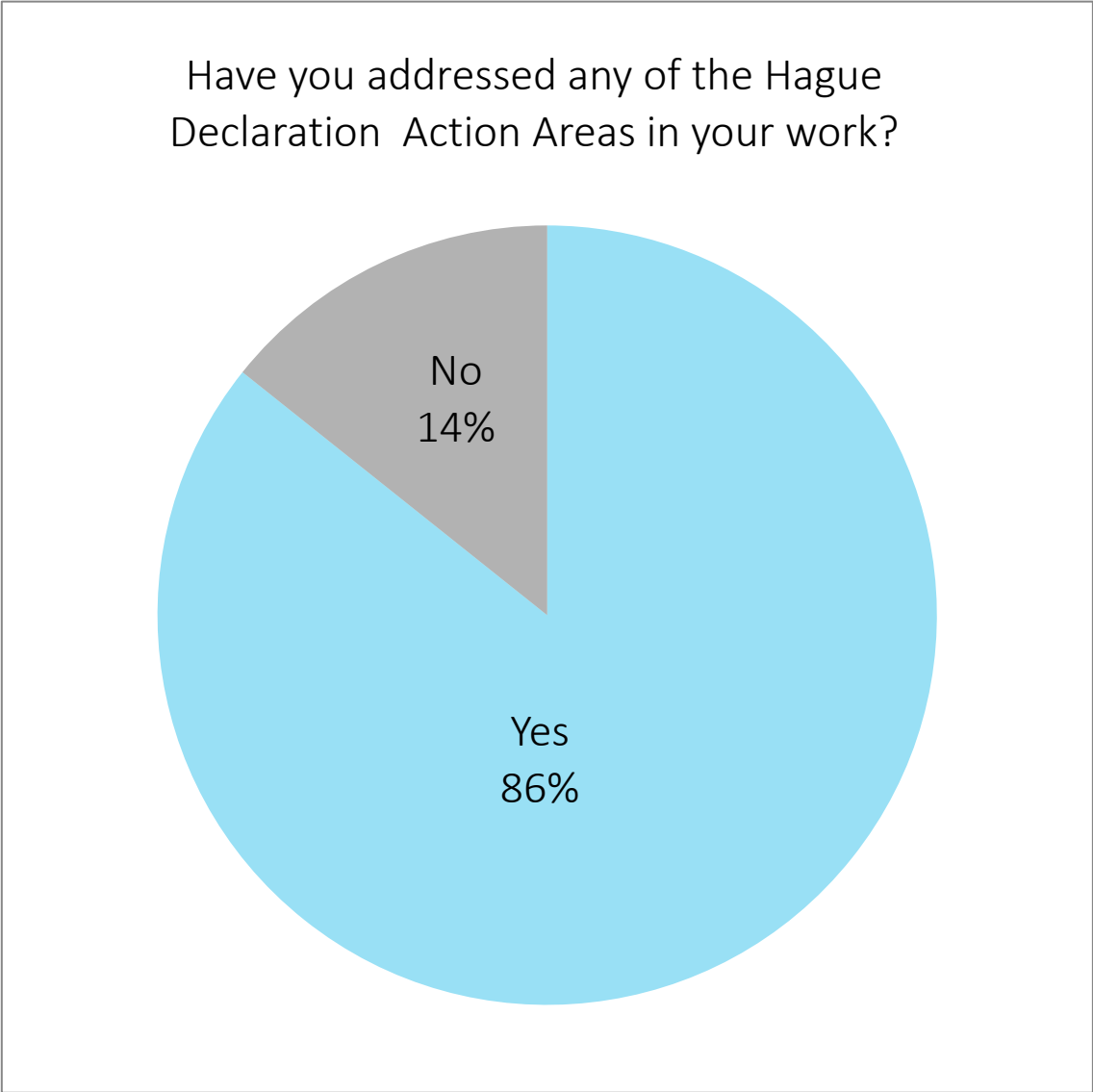
Has The Hague Declaration affected the way you work on climate change and security?
